Which areas do we cover?

The Berkshire Archaeology HER is based at Reading Borough Council and serves the community and the five unitary authorities in East Berkshire – Reading, Bracknell Forest, Slough, Windsor & Maidenhead and Wokingham.

How can you contact us?

We can be contacted Monday to Friday in office hours; please call or email to make appointments to visit and consult the HER. Also we run an Open House every Thursday afternoon for visits to the HER. Consultation of the HER is free except for commercial use. Costs for commercial enquiries will be determined after discussion of the requirement with the HER Officer.

How up to date is Berkshire Archaeology HER information?

We update our information on the Heritage Gateway every 6 months. The Berkshire Archaeology Historic Environment Record (HER) is constantly updated and the existing records amended and improved, so the information available via the Heritage Gateway may be slightly out of date compared to that held live on the HER.

What if I spot inaccurate information?

We endeavour to assure the accuracy and quality of the HER but it should be noted that the records have been created over a long period of time from a wide variety of sources and are not to a uniform standard. If you notice anything that you believe is inaccurate please use the feedback button to email us and let us know.
